Open Horsemanship Clinic

Hosting an open horsemanship clinic with Patrick King Horsemanship is a great way to bring Patrick's unique perspective, program, and style of teaching to your area. All clinics are open to horses and riders of all breeds and disciplines. Clinics last 3 days (Friday through Sunday), and can include a Thursday evening lecture, at the request of the clinic host, at no additional charge.

Topics:

The following topics can be covered independently or combined to cover more information. Specific topics for your needs can also be covered.

- ⇒ Colt Starting
- ⇒ Fundamentals
- ⇒ Horsemanship 1 through 3 (following Patrick King's Green to Gold Foundation program)
- ⇒ Trail Horsemanship

Fees:

- ⇒ Standard participant/rider fee is \$275 for a 3-day clinic. Any additional costs (mileage, air fare, etc) will be divided up amongst the riders and added to this fee.
- ⇒ Required minimum & maximum participants will be determined by the clinic topic
- ⇒ Mileage or air fare, if necessary, will be split evenly among the riders and added into the participant fees.
- ⇒ Auditor fees are \$20/day, with multi-day discounts available

Host responsibilities:

- ⇒ Promote the clinic locally and regionally by distributing flyers, placing ads, etc. (Patrick King Horsemanship will provide a clinic flyer to be distributed, and will advertise via our website, e-newsletters and social media sites.)
- ⇒ Collect a 50% non-refundable deposit for each rider when they register for the clinic
- ⇒ Collect final rider payments the morning of the clinic
- ⇒ Distribute and collect registration and release forms
- ⇒ Arrange for morning coffee/juice/snacks, bottled water throughout each day, and lunch (this can be as simple as you directing participants to local restaurants or having food available for purchase.
- ⇒ Coordinate stalling and arena rental (if necessary)
- ⇒ Direct participants and auditors to parking, stalling, arena areas, etc
- ⇒ Provide a space for Patrick King Horsemanship merchandise setup/sales
- ⇒ Provide a paddock or stalling for Patrick's horses, when necessary.

Host benefits:

- ⇒ Clinic host/coordinator will receive one rider spot in the clinic to be used at their discretion (use it to ride, sell it, give it away, etc).
- ⇒ If Patrick is not traveling with his horses, he'll likely need a saddle horse for the clinic – this is a great chance to have one of your horses worked throughout the clinic.
- ⇒ Promotion of your facility.
- ⇒ Stall/arena fees.
- ⇒ 25% of auditor fees collected.

Facility requirements:

- ⇒ Arena: We need a large enough area for the horses and riders to move around without much trouble. If you have a fenced arena, that's great. If you have a level field to work in, that's just as good. It's always a good idea to have a backup indoor arena in case of inclement weather.
- ⇒ A round corral is necessary for colt starting.
- ⇒ Parking for trucks/trailers and auditor vehicles
- ⇒ Stalls or paddocks available for horses that will be staying

Private Horsemanship Clinic

As a private clinic host, you will have control over the content, format, and riders/auditors. If you want a private clinic to educate your employees/ranch hands, or if you and your riding-buddies just want to have a more private horsemanship experience, this is a great way to go.

Topics:

The following topics can be covered independently or combined to cover more information. Specific topics for your needs can also be covered.

- ⇒ Colt Starting
- ⇒ Fundamentals
- ⇒ Horsemanship 1 through 3 (following Patrick King's Green to Gold Foundation program)
- ⇒ Trail Horsemanship

Fees:

- ⇒ Private clinic fees are \$1200/day, plus mileage or air fare (if necessary)
- ⇒ Private clinics are available from 2 to 5 days in duration.
- ⇒ Participants: You fill this clinic however you want and charge participants whatever you want. Maximum of 15 riders.
- ⇒ Auditors: It's up to you – allow auditors or not, and charge whatever you want.

Responsibilities:

- ⇒ A \$500 nonrefundable deposit is required to reserve a private clinic.
- ⇒ Distribute and collect registration and release forms.
- ⇒ Arrange for morning coffee/juice/snacks, bottled water throughout each day, and lunch (this can be as simple as you directing participants to local restaurants or having food available, catered or for purchase).
- ⇒ Coordinate stalling and arena rental (if necessary).
- ⇒ Direct participants and auditors to parking, stalling, arena areas, etc.
- ⇒ Provide a space for Patrick King Horsemanship merchandise setup/sales.
- ⇒ Provide a paddock or stalling for Patrick's horses, when necessary.

Benefits:

- ⇒ Hosting a private clinic allows you to determine the content, and size of the clinic.
- ⇒ If Patrick is not traveling with his horses, he'll likely need a saddle horse(s) for the clinic – this is a great chance to have one or more of your horses worked throughout the clinic.
- ⇒ Promotion of your facility on Patrick King Horsemanship website, e-newsletter, and social media sites.

Facility requirements:

- ⇒ Arena: We need a large enough area for the horses and riders to move around without much trouble. If you have a fenced arena, that's great. If you have a level field to work in, that's just as good. It's always a good idea to have a backup indoor arena in case of inclement weather.
- ⇒ A round corral is necessary for colt starting.
